WRITTEN REQUIREMENT:

A written essay on the theme: HOW CATHOLIC EDUCATION WILL HELP ME TO BE WHAT GOD
WANTS OF ME

DIRECTIONS: Essay will be hand written in class, collected and returned to be typed in the
Computer lab at St. Malachy.

Essay must consist of, at least. one page and no more than two typed pages.

Font: Times New Roman

Font Size: 12 (double – spaced)

Student name is NOT to be on the essay. The essay will be given a number, when handed in to teacher.

The awardee will also be based on: demonstration of their faith, leadership, desire for learning, caring spirit and efforts toward physical fitness.

In addition to the essay, points will be given for the following behavior/al accomplishments:

- Attendance at Sunday Mass/Church of worship
- Participation in the liturgical roles at Mass (server, reader, usher, choir, & other roles)
- Christian in Action Awards received
- Demerits received
- Participation in sports
- Report of effort in Physical Education

Evaluators: Three evaluators outside of school will read the essays and give recommendations to the Scholarship committee.

Scholarship committee: Five members of the St. Malachy faculty will serve on this committee. Points will be given for the above areas of behavior demonstrated by the candidates.
